

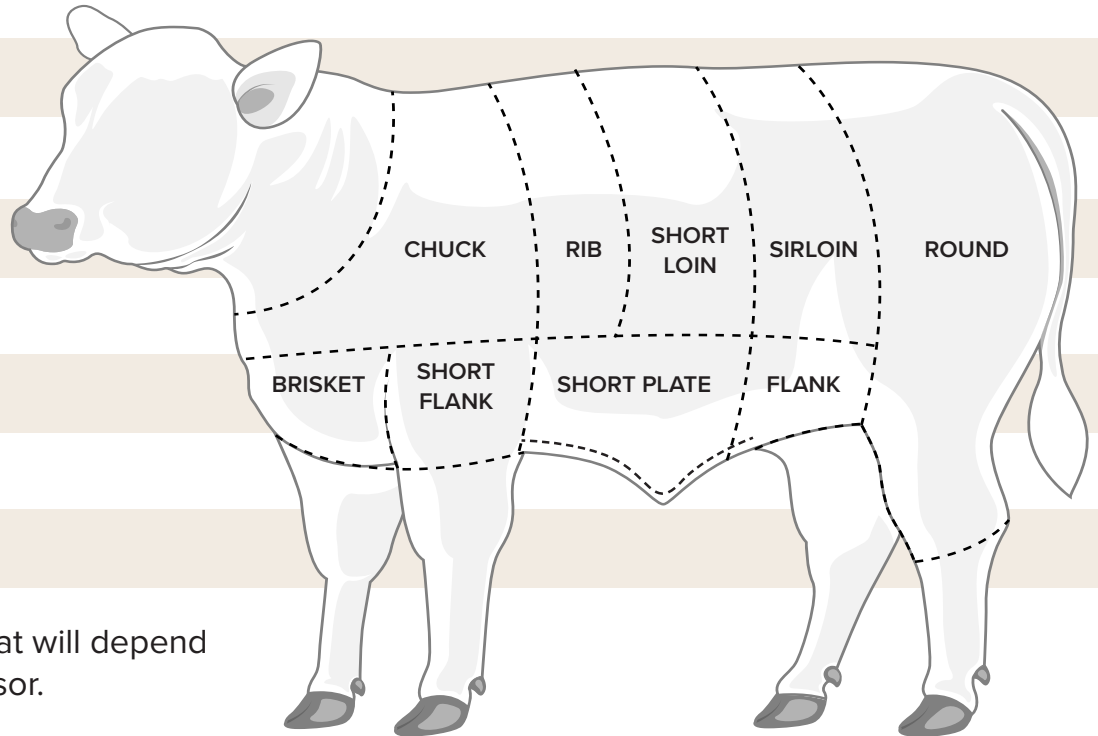
Preparing to buy a quarter of **beef**.

How much **meat** is a quarter of beef?

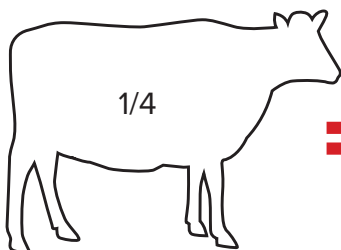
On average, a 1,300 lb market animal yields 639 lbs of edible beef.
A typical quarter of beef with a live weight of 1,300 lbs will yield:

- 7** Rib-eye steaks
- 6** T-bone steaks
- 3** Sirloin steaks
- 3** Sirloin tip steaks
- 3** Round steaks
- 6** Roasts
- 35-60** Lbs ground beef

Cuts and quantities of meat will depend on the animal and processor.
